- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative:

This bill would authorize the Office of Attorney General to issue a special license to an organization for conducting one or more "calcuttas" during a single sporting event. The license fee would be \$60. Under present law, an organization with a license for a city or county may conduct any legal game of chance in that city or county, including a calcutta. The present license fee is \$150.

A "calcutta" is a game in which competitors in a sporting event are auctioned off to players who bet on the performance of the competitors. The total amount bid (bet) by all the players is pooled. The players who bet on the winning competitors may win up to 90% of the auction pool.
