- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: This bill gives a 5 percent preference to in-state bidders when bidding on information technology equipment, products, and supplies.

The fiscal note assumes the amounts budgeted are minimum amounts and that the 5 percent preference could potentially increase these amounts by up to 5 percent. The fiscal note also assumes that no resident bidder would respond to approximately 30 percent of the bids. This is reflected in the amounts listed below.
