Narrative:

As a result of additional information from Blue Cross Blue Shield that indicated they are presently paying for these services in the PERS plan, we are able to revise the previous fiscal note. Since this service is not specifically identified as a covered service in the plan document, the actuary had developed the previous fiscal note based upon the belief that the services proposed in this bill would be new covered services for PERS. However, since BCBS is presently reimbursing for these services this would not be a new service to PERS and, therefore, there would be no fiscal effect.
