1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: SB No. 2153 would require that federally licensed grain warehouses obtain a \$250 state grain buyers license to govern their merchandising activities. Prior to 1999, these entities had been obtaining a state warehouse license with fees ranging from \$250 to \$500. There are 73 federally licensed warehouse in North Dakota ($\$250 \times 73 \times 2 = \$36,500$). This bill would also increase the license fees for roving grain buyers from \$75 to \$100 per year. There are 47 roving grain buyers in North Dakota ($\$25 \times 47 \times 2 = \$2,350$).


