Narrative:

There would be no direct cost to the state. We were unable to identify a fiscal note for local school districts on this bill since it pertains to High School Activities Association sponsored activities. Our experience tells us that the costs would vary considerably depending on the activity and the locality where it is offered. Some schools have participation fees to help defray the cost of the activity others would meet the costs with revenues from the activities or with general fund dollars.


