Prior to the referral of 1989, the State Department of Health operated a swimming pool program that established and maintained operating standards for swimming pools. Reestablishment of this program would require two FTE's for the first year. Once the program has been established it will require 1½ FTE's to monitor. The department would need two additional FTE's and associated costs identified below to carryout this program.


