BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 20 of section 54-52-01 of the 1999

 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

 20. "Wages" and "salaries" means the member's earnings in eligible employment
- 8 9 under this chapter reported as salary on the member's federal income tax 10 withholding statements, including payments for overtime earned by employees of 11 the North Dakota mill and elevator association, plus any salary reduction or salary 12 deferral amounts under 26 U.S.C. 125, 401(k), 403(b), 414(h), or 457. "Salary" 13 does not include fringe benefits such as payments for unused sick leave, personal 14 leave, vacation leave paid in a lump sum, overtime, housing allowances, 15 transportation expenses, early retirement incentive pay, severance pay, medical 16 insurance, workers' compensation benefits, disability insurance premiums or 17 benefits, or salary received by a member in lieu of previously employer-provided 18 fringe benefits under an agreement between the member and participating 19 employer. Overtime must be reported and annualized pursuant to rules adopted 20 by the board. Bonuses may be considered as salary under this section if reported 21 and annualized pursuant to rules adopted by the board.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 8 of section 54-52.6-01 of the 1999

 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8. "Wages" and "salaries" means earnings in eligible employment under this chapter reported as salary on a federal income tax withholding statement, including payments for overtime earned by employees of the North Dakota mill and elevator association, plus any salary reduction or salary deferral amounts under 26 U.S.C. 125, 401(k), 403(b), 414(h), or 457. "Salary" does not include fringe benefits such as payments for unused sick leave, personal leave, vacation leave paid in a lump sum, evertime, housing allowances, transportation expenses, early retirement, incentive pay, severance pay, medical insurance, workers' compensation benefits, disability insurance premiums or benefits, or salary received by a member in lieu of previously employer-provided fringe benefits under an agreement between an employee and a participating employer. Overtime must be reported and annualized pursuant to rules adopted by the board. Bonuses may be considered as salary under this section if reported and annualized pursuant to rules adopted by the board.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the public employees retirement fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$7,300, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the public employees retirement system board for the purpose of defraying the expenses of administering this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
