- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the payment of signing bonuses by school boards.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

School board authority - Payment of signing bonuses.

- The board of a school district may offer and, upon the signing of the contract by both parties, pay a signing bonus in an amount up to ten thousand dollars to an individual:
 - Who is licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board or approved to teach by the education standards and practices board;
 - b. Who has signed a contract of employment to serve as a full-time classroom teacher in the district; and
 - c. Who has not previously been employed by the board of the district as a classroom teacher or as an administrator.
- 2. The board may pay to the individual the signing bonus authorized by subsection 1:
 - a. In one lump sum at the time the individual signs a contract of employment; or
 - b. In two or three installments over a period of time not exceeding three years from the date the individual signs a contract of employment.
- A signing bonus paid under this section does not affect the provisions of any
 negotiated salary schedule agreed to by the teachers of a school district and the
 board of the school district.
