## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-09-55 of the 1999 Supplement to the North

  Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 15.1-09-55. School district superintendent Joint employment Accreditation.
  - 1. The superintendent of public instruction may not impose through the accreditation process any penalties or sanctions on a school district for employing a superintendent jointly with one or more other districts.
    - 2. A superintendent employed under this section may perform all administrative duties of an elementary or secondary school principal.
    - 3. The superintendent of public instruction may not require, through the accreditation process, that an employee of a school district having fewer than one hundred students in high school spend more than thirty-three percent of the employee's time performing the duties of a school principal if the school district employs a superintendent jointly with one or more other districts.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
  - School district superintendent Joint employment Teacher salaries. The board of a school district jointly employing a superintendent under the provisions of section 15.1-09-55 may use any savings realized through the joint employment of a superintendent to provide additional compensation to all classroom teachers employed by the district, notwithstanding the
