- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-09-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the state electrical board membership.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-09-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **43-09-02. State electrical board Members Terms of office Vacancies.** The
- 7 state electrical board must consist consists of five six members appointed by the governor for a
- 8 term of five years with their the terms of office so arranged that one term and only one term
- 9 <u>expires</u> <u>no more than two terms expire</u> on June thirtieth of each year. <u>One member Two</u>
- 10 <u>members</u> of the board shall represent the public and may not be directly associated with the
- 11 electrical industry. The board must include a master electrician who is a contractor, a
- 12 journeyman electrician, a consumer member of a rural electric cooperative, and a person an
- 13 individual associated with an investor-owned utility. A member of the board shall qualify
- 14 <u>qualifies</u> by taking the oath of office required of civil officers and shall hold his holds office until
- 15 his the member's successor is appointed and qualified. The governor shall fill any vacancy by
- 16 appointment for the unexpired term of office.
