- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for the insurance commissioner to perform a workers'
- 2 compensation insurance study; and to provide for an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. INSURANCE COMMISSIONER STUDY OF WORKERS'

 COMPENSATION INSURANCE REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL LEGISLATIVE

 COUNCIL RECOMMENDATIONS. During the 2001-02 interim, the insurance commissioner shall perform an independent study of the effects of competition on workers' compensation premiums; services provided to injured workers; and coverage of small, medium, and large employers and of the feasibility and desirability of allowing employers to obtain private
- 10 insurance or be self-insured for purposes of workers' compensation. The commissioner shall
- 11 report the results of this study to the legislative council no later than April 30, 2002. The
- 12 legislative council shall report its recommendations, together with any legislation required to
- 13 implement the recommendations, to the fifty-eighth legislative assembly.
- SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
 workers' compensation fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
 \$150,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the insurance commissioner for the
 purpose of funding the study of workers' compensation insurance, for the biennium beginning
- 18 July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
