- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative council study of workers' compensation insurance
- 2 study; and to provide for an appropriation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STUDY OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION
5	INSURANCE. The legislative council shall contract with an industry expert during the 2001-02
6	interim to conduct an independent study of the effects of competition on workers' compensation
7	premiums, anticipated impacts on rates, service provided to injured workers, and coverage of
8	small, medium, and large employers. The independent study must determine whether the state
9	has a large enough economic base to support workers' compensation competition and the
10	feasibility and desirability of allowing employers to obtain private insurance or be self-insured
11	for purposes of workers' compensation. The legislative council shall report its
12	recommendations to the fifty-eighth legislative assembly and to the workers compensation
13	board of directors.
14	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the workers' compensation fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$150,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the legislative council for the purpose of funding the study of workers' compensation insurance under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2003.
