- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-12.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to educational requirements for nurses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-12.1-02 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 43-12.1-02. Definitions. In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise
 requires:
 - "Advanced practice registered nurse" means a person an individual who holds a
 current license to practice in this state as an advanced practice registered nurse
 and either has a graduate degree with a nursing focus or has completed the
 educational requirements in effect when the person individual was initially licensed.
- 12 2. "Board" means the North Dakota board of nursing.
 - 3. "Licensed practical nurse" means a person an individual who holds a current license to practice in this state as a licensed practical nurse and either has an associate degree with a major in nursing graduated from an approved vocational practical nursing education program that is authorized to prepare students for licensure as practical nurses or has completed the educational requirements in effect when the person individual was initially licensed.
 - 4. "Nurse" means any person individual currently licensed as an advanced practice registered nurse, a registered nurse, or a licensed practical nurse.
 - "Nurse assistant" means a person an individual who is authorized by the board to perform nursing tasks delegated and supervised by a licensed nurse.
 - 6. "Nursing" means the performance of acts utilizing specialized knowledge, skills, and abilities for people in a variety of settings. Nursing includes the following acts,

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1 which may not be deemed to include acts of medical diagnosis or treatment or the 2 practice of medicine as defined in chapter 43-17: 3 The maintenance of health and prevention of illness. a. 4 b. Diagnosing human responses to actual or potential health problems. 5 Providing supportive and restorative care and nursing treatment, medication C. 6 administration, health counseling and teaching, case finding and referral of 7 persons individuals who are ill, injured, or experiencing changes in the normal 8 health processes. 9 d. Administration, teaching, supervision, delegation, and evaluation of health and 10 nursing practices. 11 Collaboration with other health care professionals in the implementation of the e. 12 total health care regimen and execution of the health care regimen prescribed 13 by a health care practitioner licensed under title 43. 14 7. "Prescriptive practices" means assessing the need for drugs, immunizing agents, 15 or devices and writing a prescription to be filled by a licensed pharmacist. 16 8. "Registered nurse" means a person an individual who holds a current license to 17 practice in this state as a registered nurse and either has a baccalaureate an 18 associate degree with a major in nursing, a three-year diploma from an approved 19 nursing school program, or has completed the educational requirements in effect

when the person individual was initially licensed.
