4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 16.1-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Expenditure statement required of candidates, political committees, and political parties. A candidate, political committee, or political party that makes expenditures shall file a statement listing the total amount of expenditures during the reporting period and identifying to whom any expenditure in excess of two hundred dollars was made. The candidate, political committee, or political party shall file the expenditure statement in the office of the secretary of state no later than the fourteenth day before each primary election and the twenty-first day before each general election. The candidate, political committee, or political party shall file a complete statement for the preceding two calendar years not later than the thirty-first day of January of each odd-numbered year.
