- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 25-03.2-03.1 and 50-11-02.3 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to a needs assessment and a moratorium on the expansion of
- 3 residential treatment center for children and residential child care facility bed capacity; to
- 4 provide an expiration date; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 25-03.2-03.1 of the 1999 Supplement to the
- 7 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 25-03.2-03.1. (Effective through June 30, 2001 2003) Moratorium on expansion of
- 9 residential treatment center for children bed capacity. Notwithstanding sections 25-03.2-03
- and 25-03.2-08, <u>unless a needs assessment conducted by the department indicates a need for</u>
- 11 the licensing of additional bed capacity, the department may not issue a license under this
- 12 chapter for any additional bed capacity for a residential treatment center for children above the
- 13 state's gross number of beds licensed as of June 30, 1999.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-11-02.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 16 50-11-02.3. (Effective through June 30, 2001 2003) Moratorium on expansion of
- 17 residential child care facility bed capacity. Notwithstanding sections 50-11-02 and
- 18 50-11-09, unless a needs assessment conducted by the department indicates a need for the
- 19 licensing of additional bed capacity, the department may not issue a license under this chapter
- 20 for any additional bed capacity for a residential child care facility above the state's gross
- 21 number of beds licensed as of June 30, 1999.
- 22 **SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through June 30, 2003, and
- 23 after that date is ineffective.
- 24 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
