- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 48-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the display of flags at the state capitol.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 48-05-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 48-05-01. Flags displayed on public institutions. The flag of the United States of
- 7 America shall must be displayed upon all state institutions between the hours of nine
- 8 o'clock a.m. and four o'clock p.m. of each day, weather permitting. Upon the written request of
- 9 any individual to, and upon receiving the approval of, the capitol grounds planning commission,
- 10 the flags of each federally recognized Indian tribe in this state or a flag representing the origin
- 11 of any ethnic group in the state may be displayed at the state capitol. The state shall assume
- 12 the cost of displaying any flag at the state capitol. The officials in charge of the various state
- 13 institutions shall make the necessary arrangements for carrying out the provisions of this
- 14 section.
