- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 3 of section 49-23-04 of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the one-call excavation notice system.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 3 of section 49-23-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 3. a. An operator, within forty-eight hours, or any extension of that period, after receiving an excavation notice from the center, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, unless otherwise agreed to between the excavator and operator, shall locate and mark or otherwise provide the approximate horizontal location of the underground facilities of the operator. Physically marking the location of underground facilities is not required if an operator with underground facilities mapped on a geographical information system informs the excavator that the excavation will not affect that operator's underground facilities based on the information provided by the excavator and the operator provides the excavator with the name and address of the entity with the geographical information system. Upon request of an excavator, the entity operating the geographic information system shall provide a map of the excavation site at cost. As used in this section, a geographic information system is a system that records the horizontal location of underground facilities on a map that displays buildings and streets.
