- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-62.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to student loan reductions for education majors.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-62.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Student loan reduction - Education majors.

- An individual who attends a public institution of higher education in this state as an
  education major may obtain from the Bank of North Dakota a student loan at an
  interest rate of zero percent.
- 2. Once the individual becomes licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board or approved to teach by the education standards and practices board and signs a contract of employment with a school district in this state for the provision of classroom teaching services, the individual may apply to the Bank of North Dakota for a loan reduction.
- The Bank of North Dakota shall consider all applications under this section in chronological order.
- 4. Upon approval, the Bank of North Dakota shall waive repayment on a student loan obtained under this section for so long as the individual remains under contract with a school district in this state and provides classroom teaching services.
- 5. On each annual anniversary date of the individual's employment with a school district in this state for the provision of classroom teaching services, the Bank of North Dakota shall reduce the individual's repayment obligation on the student loan provided under subsection 1 by ten percent of the outstanding balance.

6. If the individual ceases to be employed by a school district in this state in the provision of teaching services, the Bank of North Dakota shall impose repayment requirements at the going interest rate for similar student loans.
