- A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-17-41 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the duty to report injuries.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-17-41 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 43-17-41. Duty of physicians and others to report injury Penalty.
 - 1. Any physician, physician assistant, or other medical or mental health professional, any individual licensed under chapter 43-12.1 who has under his charge or care or performs any professional services diagnosis or treatment for any person individual suffering from any wound, injury, or other physical trauma inflicted:
 - a. Inflicted by his the individual's own act or by the act of another by means of a knife, gun, or pistol, shall as soon as practicable report the wound, injury, or trauma to a law enforcement agency in the county in which the care was rendered; or which he
 - <u>b.</u> Which the individual performing diagnosis or treatment has reasonable cause to suspect was inflicted in violation of any criminal law of this state, shall as soon as practicable report the <u>same wound, injury, or trauma</u> to <u>the sheriff or state's attorney of a law enforcement agency in the county in which <u>such the care was rendered.</u></u>
 - 2. The report <u>under subsection 1</u> must state the name of the injured person, if known, his whereabouts, individual and the character and extent of his the individual's injuries.
- 23 2. 3. When a report of domestic violence, as defined in section 14-07.1-01, or a report of physical injury resulting from a sexual offense as defined in chapter 12.1-20 is

- 1 made to a law enforcement agency as required by this section, the injured 2 individual must be provided with information regarding a domestic violence sexual 3 assault organization as defined in section 14-07.1-01 or other victims' assistance 4 program by the physician, physician assistant, or any individual licensed under 5 chapter 43-12.1, unless it is known that the information has previously been 6 provided to the injured individual. 7 The reports mandated by this section must be made as soon as practicable and 8 may be either oral or in writing. Oral reports must be followed by written reports 9 within forty-eight hours if so requested by the sheriff or state's attorney to whom 10 the oral report is originally made. 11
- 11 3. 5. Any person individual required to report as provided by this section who willfully fails to do so is guilty of an infraction.
- 4. 6. Any person individual making or not making a report in good faith pursuant to this section is immune from liability for making said or not making a report.
