- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to restrictions on guides and outfitters; and to amend and reenact
- 3 subsection 17 of section 20.1-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the powers
- 4 of the director of the game and fish department.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 17 of section 20.1-02-05 of the 1999
 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 17. Subject to the provisions of chapter 28-32, adopt rules for the licensing of guides or outfitters; and may require records and reports as the director determines necessary. The director may, after due hearing as provided in chapter 28-32, revoke or refuse to renew the license of any a person who violates the rules or fails to provide the records and reports. Any person who acts as a guide or outfitter without a license is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Guides and outfitters - Rules - Restrictions. An individual may not:

- Act as a guide or outfitter or advertise or otherwise represent to the public that the individual is a guide or outfitter without first securing a license in accordance with this title and the applicable rules of the director;
- Act as a certified guide or outfitter or advertise or otherwise represent to the public that the individual meets the qualifications of being certified without first complying with section 20.1-03-36;
- 3. Act as a hunting guide or outfitter on land owned by or leased by the department
 for the purpose of upland game hunting;

1 Act as a hunting guide or outfitter on land on which the department has obtained 2 an easement or has entered into a lease, granting the right of public access to that 3 land for hunting or recreational use for the purpose of upland game hunting; 4 Provide guiding or outfitting services to a person who has not obtained the <u>5.</u> appropriate license for the species sought by that person; or 5 6 Willfully and substantially misrepresent that person's facilities, prices, equipment, <u>6.</u> 7 services, or hunting or fishing opportunities as a guide or outfitter.
