- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
- 2 of creating cost-sharing or funding mechanisms for the unexpected discovery of cultural
- 3 resources within local road projects.
- 4 **WHEREAS**, the unexpected discovery of cultural resources after a local road project
- 5 has begun can create an enormous fiscal burden on the local road authority; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the local road authority has almost no control over the extent of
- 7 investigation that results and has few options except termination or redesign of the project upon
- 8 discovery of unexpected cultural resources; and
- 9 **WHEREAS**, a cost-sharing or funding mechanism including appropriate state agencies
- 10 and the local road authority would diffuse the risk of unexpectedly discovering cultural
- 11 resources;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 13 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 14 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of creating cost-sharing
- 15 or funding mechanisms for the unexpected discovery of cultural resources within local road
- 16 projects; and
- 17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 19 the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
