- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
- 2 of creating cost-sharing or funding mechanisms for the unexpected discovery of cultural or
- 3 paleontological resources within local road projects.
- 4 WHEREAS, the unexpected discovery of cultural or paleontological resources after a
- 5 local road project has begun can create an enormous fiscal burden on the local road authority:

- 7 WHEREAS, the local road authority has almost no control over the extent of
- 8 investigation that results and has few options except termination or redesign of the project upon
- 9 discovery of unexpected cultural or paleontological resources; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a cost-sharing or funding mechanism including appropriate state agencies
- 11 and the local road authority would diffuse the risk of unexpectedly discovering cultural or
- 12 paleontological resources;
 - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 14 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 15 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of creating cost-sharing
- 16 or funding mechanisms for the unexpected discovery of cultural or paleontological resources
- 17 within local road projects; and
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 19 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 20 the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
