- between the legislative, executive, and judicial branches and the distinction between the 2

 - WHEREAS, Section 26 of Article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota provides that the legislative, executive, and judicial branches are co-equal branches of government; and
- 6 WHEREAS, with the exception of the power of the people to propose and enact laws by
- 7 the initiative, the sole legislative power of the state is vested in the Legislative Assembly, the
- 8 judicial power of the state is vested in the courts, and the the administrative power of the state
- 9 is vested in the executive branch; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the thoughtful and prudent exercise of these powers by each of these
- 11 separate and coequal branches, with due respect and consideration for authority and
- 12 responsibility of the other, is in the best interest of the people;
 - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
