- Services would be better served if the department offered a "one-stop" access to services; and

 WHEREAS, the realigning of divisions within the Department of Human Services may

 lead to more effective and cost-efficient ways of providing services;
 - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
 - That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of realigning the divisions within the Department of Human Services; and
