HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3042 Fifty-seventh

1	A concurrent resolution urging Congress to ensure the economic viability and competitiveness
2	of American farmers by adopting legislation that would grant states the authority to issue state
3	registrations to parties who wish to import Canadian crop protection products that are identical
4	or substantially similar to products registered with the Environmental Protection Agency for use
5	in the United States.
6	WHEREAS, agriculture plays an important role in the economic viability and culture of
7	the state of North Dakota; and
8	WHEREAS, crop protection products are used to produce high-quality and safe
9	commodities marketed nationally and internationally; and
10	WHEREAS, farmers in this state use crop protection products in a safe and responsible
11	manner; and
12	WHEREAS, farmers need access to comparably priced crop protection products as
13	those available to Canadian producers to be competitive and economically viable; and
14	WHEREAS, the crop protection product industry uses the United States and Canadian
15	border to segment markets and charge substantially different prices for crop protection
16	products; and
17	WHEREAS, North Dakota farmers are prohibited by federal law and regulations to
18	import and use Canadian crop protection products without the consent of the product registrant
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
20	OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
21	That the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to
22	adopt legislation granting states the authority to issue state registrations to parties who wish to
23	import Canadian crop protection products that are identical or substantially similar to products
24	registered with the Environmental Protection Agency for use in the Unites States; and

- 2 resolution to the Secretary of Agriculture, the Administrator of the Environmental Protection
- 3 Agency, the chairmen of the Senate and House Agriculture Committees, and to each member
