- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study issues relating to genetic 2 modification, including impacts on health, the food supply, and the future, and actions by other 3 jurisdictions relating to experimental medicine, product labeling, and promulgation of accurate 4 information regarding genetic modification efforts that exist or are expected to exist in the near 5 future. 6 WHEREAS, through genetic modification, scientists are exploring the possibility of 7 eliminating genetic diseases such as Alzheimer's, diabetes, and cancer; and 8 WHEREAS, through genetic modification, scientists are exploring the possibility of 9 removing undesirable traits such as alcoholism, schizophrenia, and drug abuse; and 10 WHEREAS, through genetic modification, scientists are exploring the possibility of 11 producing artificial hormones and producing substances such as vitamins, antibiotics, and other 12 drugs; and 13 WHEREAS, through genetic modification, food can be produced with less need for 14 chemicals such as insecticides; and 15 WHEREAS, with respect to genetically modified food and with respect to genetic 16 modification in medicine, monitoring and proactive research is needed to determine the 17 short-term and long-term benefits and detriments of such efforts; and
  - WHEREAS, the issue of genetic modification must be viewed with a willingness to explore the gamut of opportunities that modern science has made available;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Legislative Council study issues relating to genetic modification, including impacts on health, the food supply, and the future, and actions by other jurisdictions relating to experimental medicine, product labeling, and promulgation of accurate information regarding genetic modification efforts that exist or are expected to exist in the near future; and
