4	WHEREAS, North Dakota State University reported it incurred credit card fees for
5	accepting payments by credit cards exceeding \$95,000 in the year 2000 and there are 10 other
6	state-funded universities with credit card fee expenses in this state; and
7	WHEREAS, in addition to any financial impact credit card fees may be imposing on our
8	state's economy, there also may be a social impact on the students, regressing their
9	opportunities for future growth due to credit card debt; and
10	WHEREAS, with the increase of combined credit card and student loan debt, more
11	students may be dropping out of school without a degree and more students may be leaving
12	the state to seek higher paying jobs; and
13	WHEREAS, a detailed study of the financial impact of credit card fees could determine
14	the financial burdens on North Dakota public institutions of higher education and North Dakota
15	taxpayers;
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA,
17	THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
18	That the Legislative Council study the financial impact of credit card fees imposed on
19	public institutions of higher education and the social effects of credit card debt on young
20	adults; and
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
22	recommendations, together with any legislation necessary to implement the recommendations,
23	to the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly.
