## 4 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 5 This amendment removes the agriculture commissioner as a constitutionally elected official.
- 6 This amendment becomes effective January 1, 2005.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

## REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 9 That the following proposed amendments to sections 2 and 5 of article V of the
- 10 Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of
- 11 North Dakota at the general election to be held in 2002, in accordance with section 16 of
- 12 article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.
- 13 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 2 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota
- 14 is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **Section 2.** The qualified electors of the state at the times and places of choosing
- 16 members of the legislative assembly shall choose a governor, lieutenant governor, agriculture
- 17 commissioner, attorney general, auditor, insurance commissioner, three public service
- 18 commissioners, secretary of state, superintendent of public instruction, tax commissioner, and
- 19 treasurer. The legislative assembly may by law provide for a department of labor to be
- 20 administered by a public official who may be either elected or appointed.
- The powers and duties of the agriculture commissioner, attorney general, auditor,
- 22 insurance commissioner, public service commissioners, secretary of state, superintendent of
- 23 public instruction, tax commissioner, and treasurer must be prescribed by law. If the legislative
- 24 assembly establishes a labor department, the powers and duties of the officer administering
- 25 that department must be prescribed by law.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 5 of article V of the Constitution of North Dakota 2 is amended and reenacted as follows: 3 Section 5. The qualified electors shall choose the elected state officials at a time 4 designated by the legislative assembly. The elected state officials shall serve until their 5 successors are duly qualified. Terms of office of the elected officials except the public service 6 commissioners are four years, except that in 2004 the agriculture commissioner, attorney 7 general, secretary of state, and tax commissioner are elected to a term of two years. The terms 8 of the public service commissioners are six years, so arranged that one of them is elected every 9 two years. The terms of the governor and lieutenant governor begin on December fifteenth 10 following their election. 11 If two or more candidates for any executive office other than for governor and lieutenant 12 governor receive an equal and highest number of votes, the legislative assembly in joint 13 session shall choose one of them for the office. 14 **SECTION 3. APPLICATION.** If approved by the voters, this measure does not affect the term of office to which the agriculture commissioner was elected on November 7, 2000. 15 16 **SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by the voters, this measure becomes 17 effective on January 1, 2005.
