## 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state board for

2 vocational and technical education; and to provide for a legislative council study.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the 5 funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 7 other income, to the state board for vocational and technical education for the purpose of 8 defraying the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2001, and 9 ending June 30, 2003, as follows: 10 Salaries and wages \$2,946,750 11 596,147 Operating expenses 12 60,000 Equipment 13 Grants 22,920,288 14 422,300 Information technology technical 15 education program development grants 16 Adult farm management 525,760 17 Work force training 1,350,000 18 Postsecondary education vocational grants 357,452 19 Total all funds \$29,178,697 20 Less estimated income 14,887,742 21 Total general fund appropriation \$14,290,955 22 SECTION 2. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES - WORKFORCE 23 DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL REPORT TO FIFTY-EIGHTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The

24 workforce development council shall prepare a report annually on workforce training and

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1 development activities of the North Dakota university system, job service North Dakota, 2 department of human services, state board for vocational and technical education, department 3 of commerce, and other workforce partners. The workforce development council shall present 4 the reports to the House and Senate appropriations committees of the fifty-eighth legislative 5 assembly. 6 SECTION 3. INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM 7 **DEVELOPMENT GRANTS.** The state board for vocational and technical education shall use 8 the amount appropriated in the line item entitled information technology technical education

9 program development grants in section 1 of this Act to contract with a nonprofit private entity to

10 provide assistance to schools in information technology technical education program

11 development.

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SECTION 4. WORKFORCE TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT - LEGISLATIVE

13 **COUNCIL STUDY.** During the 2001-02 interim, the legislative council shall consider studying 14 the various workforce training and development programs administered by agencies of the state of North Dakota and the feasibility and desirability of consolidating in a single agency the 15 16 funding and administration of those programs. Agencies to be considered as part of the study 17 include job service North Dakota, the department of economic development and finance, the 18 state board for vocational and technical education, and the North Dakota university system. 19 The legislative council shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any 20 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the fifty-eighth legislative assembly.
