- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to pilot programs for recruiting and retaining state employees in
- 3 hard-to-fill occupations; and to provide an expiration date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:
- 7 State employee recruitment and retention bonus pilot programs Criteria -
- Limitations. State agencies may develop pilot programs to provide bonuses to recruit or retain
  classified state employees in hard-to-fill occupations.
- 1. State agencies may pay recruitment and retention bonuses under this section only if:
  - a. The agency has a written policy in place identifying eligible positions or occupations and provisions for providing and receiving bonuses;
  - The agency has filed a copy of the written policy with the central personnel division; and
  - c. The agency reports to the central personnel division each bonus provided to an employee under the pilot program.
  - State agencies must fund bonus pilot programs from within its agency salaries and wages budget.
  - The central personnel division shall periodically report to a designated legislative committee on the implementation, progress, and bonuses provided under agency recruitment and retention bonus pilot programs.
- 4. Bonuses paid under this section are not fiscal irregularities under section 54-14-03.1.

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- 1 **SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through June 30, 2003, and
- 2 after that date is ineffective.
