## Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly of North Dakota In Regular Session Commencing Tuesday, January 9, 2001

SENATE BILL NO. 2151 (Government and Veterans Affairs Committee) (At the request of the Office of Management and Budget)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 54-27-21 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the minimum value for reporting fixed assets; and to declare an emergency.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-27-21 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**54-27-21. Fixed asset minimum reporting value.** All state departments, agencies, <u>boards, bureaus, commissions, industries,</u> and institutions shall include all fixed assets under their control in their financial statements, except those having a value of <del>seven hundred and fifty five thousand</del> dollars or less. The state auditor is authorized to provide for the written exemption of specific fixed assets having a value of more than <del>seven hundred and fifty five thousand</del> dollars when <del>such</del> <u>an</u> exemption is justified upon generally accepted accounting principles.

**SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
