- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-31-16 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to detection of deception examiner fees.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-31-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 43-31-16. Examiner licensed in another state exempt from examination. An
- 7 applicant who is an examiner, licensed under the laws of another state of the United States,
- 8 may be issued a license without examination by the attorney general, in his the attorney
- 9 <u>general's</u> discretion, upon payment of a fee of twenty-five thirty-five dollars, and the production
- 10 of satisfactory proof:
- 1. That the applicant is at least twenty-one years of age;
- 12 2. That the applicant is a citizen of the United States;
- 13 3. That he the applicant is of good moral character;
- That the requirements for the licensing of examiners in such particular state of the
 United States were at the date of licensing, substantially equivalent to the
 requirements then in force in this state; and
- That the applicant had lawfully engaged in the administration of polygraph
 examinations under the laws of such state for at least two years prior to his the
 application for license hereunder.
