- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 39-13-09 of the 1999 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- a. "Tourist-oriented directional sign" means a sign providing identification of and directional information for tourist-related businesses, services, or activities a tourist-oriented business, service, or activity.
- b. "Tourist-related business, service, or activity" means rural agricultural business and tourism attractions, including recreation, historical sites, festival and cultural events, lodging and food services which are singularly and uniquely related to historical, cultural, or recreational tourist attractions, and guide services, a business, including a seasonal agricultural products business; service; or activity the major portion the income or visitors of which is derived during the normal business season from motorists not residing in the immediate area of the business, service, or activity; but does not include any business operated under a franchise agreement.
