6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 12.1-17-01 of the North Dakota
 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 2. Simple assault is a class B misdemeanor except The offense is:
 - a. A class C felony when the victim is a peace officer or correctional institution employee acting in an official capacity, which the actor knows to be a fact, a person engaged in a judicial proceeding, or a member of a municipal or volunteer fire department or emergency medical services personnel unit or emergency department worker in the performance of the member's duties, in which case the offense is a class C felony.
 - <u>b.</u> A class A misdemeanor when the victim is an actor's family or household member as defined in subsection 4 of section 14-07.1-01.
 - <u>c.</u> A class B misdemeanor except as provided in subdivision a or b.
- SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 12.1-17-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- The sentence for an offense against an actor's family or household member as

 defined in subsection 4 of section 14-07.1-01 must include an order for an

 assessment and counseling with a domestic violence program or other agency that

- 1 provides professional services, unless the court makes written findings for the
- 2 <u>record explaining why such a sentence would be inappropriate.</u>
