- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 40-09-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the salary of city commissioners.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 40-09-06 of the 1999 Supplement to the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 40-09-06. Style of board Oath and salary of commissioners. The commissioners and the president of the board constitute the board of city commissioners and shall take an oath faithfully to perform the duties of their respective offices. The monthly salary of each city commissioner must be fixed by ordinance, but the compensation shall not exceed the following
- 10 limitations based upon the population of the city according to the latest state or federal census:
- 1. In cities not exceeding one thousand in population, fifty sixty dollars.
- In cities over one thousand and not exceeding two thousand in population, sixty
 seventy-five dollars.
- In cities over two thousand and not exceeding four thousand in population, ninety
 one hundred ten dollars.
 - In cities over four thousand and not exceeding six thousand in population, one hundred twenty fifty dollars.
- In cities over six thousand and not exceeding eight thousand in population, two
 hundred five fifty dollars.
- 20 6. In cities over eight thousand and not exceeding twelve thousand in population, two 21 three hundred seventy twenty-five dollars.
- 7. In cities over twelve thousand and not exceeding thirty thousand in population, three four hundred ninety seventy dollars.

- In cities over thirty thousand and not exceeding forty thousand in population, six
 eight hundred sixty dollars.
- 9. In cities having a population of over forty thousand, eight nine hundred ten eighty
 dollars.
- 5 The president of a commission may receive a salary of up to fifty percent more than the level
- 6 set for each commissioner upon resolution by the board of city commissioners.
