1 A BILL for an Act to provide for state government performance measurement.

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

3 **SECTION 1. Government performance committee - Appointment - Acceptance of**
4 **funds.** An eight-member government performance committee is created. The legislative
5 council, during each biennium, shall appoint four members of the legislative assembly to the
6 committee. The governor, during each biennium, shall appoint four executive branch
7 representatives to the committee. The governor shall designate one of the executive branch
8 representatives as chairman of the committee. The committee may accept gifts, grants, or
9 assistance to accomplish its purpose.

10 **SECTION 2. Government performance committee - Powers and duties.** The
11 government performance committee may meet and conduct its business during the legislative
12 session and in the interim between legislative sessions. The committee shall review program
13 effectiveness by focusing on program impacts and results, service quality, and customer
14 satisfaction. During each biennium, the committee shall select at least five agencies for review
15 of each agency's strategic plan and performance measures.

16 **SECTION 3. Performance reporting.** Each agency selected for review by the
17 government performance committee annually shall prepare and present a performance report
18 to the government performance committee. The report must include an analysis of the
19 agency's actual performance results. During each regular session of the legislative assembly,
20 each selected agency shall present its most recent performance report to the appropriations
21 committees of the legislative assembly.
