## ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1444

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 54-59-17 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to the membership of the educational technology council.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 54-59-17 of the North Dakota  
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 2. The educational technology council consists of:
- 7 a. The chief information officer.
  - 8 b. The superintendent of public instruction or the superintendent's designee.
  - 9 c. The commissioner of higher education or the commissioner's designee.
  - 10 d. A representative appointed by the state board for vocational and technical  
11 education.
  - 12 e. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees  
13 submitted by the North Dakota association of technology leaders.
  - 14 f. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees  
15 submitted by the North Dakota council of educational leaders.
  - 16 g. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees  
17 submitted by the North Dakota school boards association.
  - 18 h. A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees  
19 submitted by the North Dakota association of special education directors.
  - 20 i. ~~Two representatives of school districts, one of which~~ A school district  
21 representative who is appointed by the governor and who represents a school  
22 district that has an enrollment in kindergarten through grade twelve of fewer  
23 than four hundred, ~~appointed by the governor.~~

- 1                   j.    A school district representative who is appointed by the governor, who is  
2                            licensed to teach by the educational standards and practices board, and who  
3                            is employed by a public school district in this state as a classroom teacher.

- 5           k- l.   A representative appointed by the governor from a list of three nominees  
6                            submitted by the state association of non public schools.
