## ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2389

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 15.1-27-26 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to school district transportation payments.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 15.1-27-26 of the North Dakota  
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 1. Each school district providing transportation to students in contract schoolbuses or  
7 in district-owned and operated schoolbuses, and each school district with students  
8 riding commercial buses to and from school is entitled to receive the following  
9 amounts:
- 10 a. Twenty-five cents per mile [1.61 kilometers] for each schoolbus and school  
11 vehicle having a capacity of nine or fewer students and transporting students  
12 who reside outside the incorporated limits of the city in which the students'  
13 school is located.
- 14 b. Sixty-seven cents per mile [1.61 kilometers] for each schoolbus and school  
15 vehicle having a capacity of ten or more students and transporting students  
16 who reside outside the incorporated limits of the city in which the students'  
17 school is located.
- 18 c. Twenty-five cents per mile [1.61 kilometers] for each schoolbus and school  
19 vehicle having a capacity of nine or fewer students and transporting students  
20 who reside within the incorporated limits of a city in which the students' school  
21 is located.
- 22 d. ~~Thirty-five~~ Fifty cents per mile [1.61 kilometers] for each schoolbus and  
23 school vehicle having a capacity of ten or more students and transporting

- 1 students who reside within the incorporated limits of a city in which the  
2 students' school is located.
- 3 e. Twenty cents for each one-way trip by a student who rides a schoolbus or a  
4 commercial bus to or from school and who resides within the incorporated  
5 limits of the city in which the student's school is located.
