**ENGROSSED HOUSE CONCURRENT  
RESOLUTION NO. 3027**

1 A concurrent resolution urging the Superintendent of Public Instruction, all North Dakota school  
2 district superintendents, and the boards of all North Dakota school districts to work with local,  
3 state, and federal military and veterans organizations to observe and promote Veterans Day by  
4 developing and disseminating to students in the elementary and secondary schools of this state  
5 educational materials that strengthen students' awareness of the contributions and sacrifices  
6 made by veterans so that freedom can be enjoyed by everyone.

7 **WHEREAS**, North Dakotans are among the millions who have served in the armed  
8 forces of this country; and

9 **WHEREAS**, North Dakotans who served in the armed forces have, through their  
10 contributions and sacrifices, demonstrated their heroism and their unwavering love of this  
11 country; and

12 **WHEREAS**, in recent years, fewer and fewer individuals and families have had close  
13 personal ties to those who served in the armed forces of this country; and

14 **WHEREAS**, our younger citizens are consequently coming of age without having an  
15 appropriate understanding of the important accomplishments and achievements resulting from  
16 service in the armed forces of this country; and

17 **WHEREAS**, as our younger citizens mature, they will need to understand that the  
18 defense of freedom, however defined, comes at a cost that can never be repaid; and

19 **WHEREAS**, as our younger citizens mature, they will need to understand our country's  
20 history of military action, and the need for civilian control of the armed forces;

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
22 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

23 That the Fifty-eighth Legislative Assembly urges the Superintendent of Public  
24 Instruction, all North Dakota school district superintendents, and the boards of all North Dakota  
25 school districts to work with local, state, and federal military and veterans organizations to
