

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3051

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study economic development efforts
2 in the state, including establishment of a Red River Valley business and technology
3 development zone and methods through which programs receiving funding from the United
4 States Department of Agriculture rural economic area partnership, empowerment zone,
5 enterprise community, and champion community programs can be enhanced.

6 **WHEREAS**, technology zones in other states have been used to stimulate the growth of
7 technology-based businesses and jobs by aiding in the creation of recognized clusters of new
8 and emerging businesses; and

9 **WHEREAS**, businesses and communities in this state have received funding assistance
10 from the United States Department of Agriculture rural economic area partnership,
11 empowerment zone, enterprise community, and champion community programs; and

12 **WHEREAS**, establishment of technology zones such as a Red River Valley business
13 and technology development zone and development of rural economic area partnerships and
14 empowerment zones could provide needed economic development in the state; and

15 **WHEREAS**, enhancement of current state economic development programs is needed
16 to assist entrepreneurs and communities in the state;

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
18 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

19 That the Legislative Council study economic development efforts in the state, including
20 establishment of a Red River Valley business and technology development zone and methods
21 through which programs receiving funding from the United States Department of Agriculture
22 rural economic area partnership, empowerment zone, enterprise community, and champion
23 community programs can be enhanced; and

- 1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
- 2 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 3 the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
