1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state board for

2 vocational and technical education; to require a report to the budget section; to provide

3 statements of legislative intent; and to provide for a transfer from the student loan trust fund.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the state board for vocational and technical education for the purpose of
defraying the expenses of its various divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2003, and
ending June 30, 2005, as follows:

1 SECTION 2. POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION VOCATIONAL GRANTS -

2 **CATEGORY II - REPORT TO THE BUDGET SECTION.** The postsecondary education 3 vocational grants - category II line item in section 1 is to provide funding for career and 4 technical education programs offered through the North Dakota university system in high 5 demand occupations and growth industries in North Dakota. The state board for vocational and 6 technical education shall report to the December 2004 meeting of the budget section on the 7 distribution of the postsecondary education vocational grants - category II for the biennium 8 beginning July 1, 2003, and ending June 30, 2005. 9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - 2005-07 BIENNIUM GRANTS. It is the intent of

10 the fifty-eighth legislative assembly that the executive budget recommend continued funding for 11 the postsecondary education vocational grants - category II for the biennium beginning July 1, 12 2005, and ending June 30, 2007. 13 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - HIGHER EDUCATION FUNDING. It is the 14 intent of the fifty-eighth legislative assembly that the funds totaling \$2,350,000 included in the state board for vocational and technical education for workforce training and for postsecondary 15 16 education grants - category II be considered by the North Dakota university system as a part of 17 higher education's share of total general fund spending. 18 SECTION 5. STUDENT LOAN TRUST FUND TRANSFER. The industrial commission

shall transfer to the state board for vocational and technical education the sum of \$1,000,000
from the North Dakota student loan trust fund, appropriated for the postsecondary education
vocational grants - category II in section 1 of this Act.
