1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 19-03.1-09 and subsection 4 of
2 section 19-03.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to controlled substances.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 19-03.1-09 of the North Dakota
5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 4. Depressants. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule,
7 any material, compound, mixture, or preparation that contains any quantity of the
8 following substances having a depressant effect on the central nervous system:

9 a. Any compound, mixture, or preparation containing:

10 (1) Amobarbital;

11 (2) Secobarbital;

12 (3) Pentobarbital;

13 or any salt thereof and one or more other active medicinal ingredients which
14 are not listed in any schedule.

15 b. Any suppository dosage form containing:

16 (1) Amobarbital;

17 (2) Secobarbital;

18 (3) Pentobarbital;

19 or any salt of any of these drugs and approved by the food and drug
20 administration for marketing only as a suppository.

21 c. Any substance that contains any quantity of a derivative of barbituric acid, or
22 any salt of a derivative of barbituric acid, except those substances which are
23 specifically listed in other schedules thereof.

24 d. Buprenorphine.

21 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 19-03.1-11 of the North Dakota
22 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 23 4. Depressants. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule,
24 any material, compound, mixture, or preparation containing any quantity of the
25 following substances, including their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers whenever
26 the existence of those salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within the
27 specific chemical designation:
- 28 a. Alprazolam.
 - 29 b. Barbitol.
 - 30 c. Bromazepam.
 - 31 d. Butorphanol.
