

**SENATE BILL NO. 2218**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 43-43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the creation of limited or specialty practice licenses within the practice of  
3 environmental health.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 **43-43-04. Powers and duties of state health officer.** The state health officer shall  
8 adopt rules consistent with and necessary for the implementation and enforcement of this  
9 chapter, including rules concerning the:

- 10 1. Qualifications and requirements for licensure under this chapter.
- 11 2. Application for licensure and renewal of license.
- 12 3. Licensure.
- 13 4. Fees that may not exceed fifty dollars for licensure fees.
- 14 5. Scope of practice.
- 15 6. Ethical standards of conduct.
- 16 7. Continuing competency and education requirements.
- 17 8. Grievances and complaints.
- 18 9. Reimbursement of advisory board expenses.
- 19 10. Emergency exemptions as to requirements for licensure under this chapter.
- 20 11. Qualifications and requirements for specialty licenses or credentials within the  
21 scope of practice of an environmental health practitioner, including specialty  
22 licenses or credentials for limited practice areas.
