

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4014

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study methods for funding and
2 providing law enforcement training in this state.

3 **WHEREAS**, law enforcement training is critical in providing effective law enforcement
4 service to the people of North Dakota; and

5 **WHEREAS**, funding for this critical training has been difficult to maintain because of
6 budget constraints at the federal, state, and local levels; and

7 **WHEREAS**, there is a need to determine the most cost-effective ways of providing this
8 training so that the safety of law enforcement personnel and the public can be preserved;

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
10 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

11 That the Legislative Council study methods for funding and providing law enforcement
12 training in this state; and

13 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
14 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
15 the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
