

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4030

Introduced by

Senator Trenbeath

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the requirements for the
2 registration and licensing of snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle dealers.

3 **WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the Legislative Assembly to review existing laws to
4 ensure that they address the problems they are intended to rectify; and

5 **WHEREAS**, current North Dakota law does not establish specific requirements for the
6 registration and licensing of snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle dealers; and

7 **WHEREAS**, specific requirements for the registration and licensing of other vehicle
8 dealers are provided in North Dakota law; and

9 **WHEREAS**, North Dakota citizens and the Department of Transportation have
10 previously experienced problems with snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle dealers who failed to
11 deliver certificates of title or remit fees collected on behalf of customers; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the value of snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles has increased
13 significantly during the past few years;

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
15 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

16 That the Legislative Council study the requirements for the registration and licensing of
17 snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle dealers and the desirability of adopting laws that provide
18 specific requirements and criteria for qualification as a snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle dealer;
19 and

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
22 the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly.
