1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 36-21.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the raffling of livestock.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 36-21.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **36-21.1-09. Use of certain birds as advertising devices - Use of live beef or dairy**  
7 **cattle as raffle prizes - Gifts of animals.**

- 8 1. No person may sell, offer for sale, raffle, offer, or give as a prize, premium, or use  
9 as an advertising device, chicks, ducklings, or goslings younger than four weeks of  
10 age in quantities of less than twelve birds to an individual person. Persons  
11 engaging in the business of selling chicks, ducklings, or goslings for agricultural or  
12 wildlife purposes are exempt from the provisions of this section, but only when  
13 selling for such purposes.
- 14 2. An eligible organization authorized to conduct games of chance under  
15 chapter 53-06.1 may raffle live beef or dairy cattle, bison, sheep, horses, and pigs,  
16 provided each raffle ticket contains a statement that the person who wins the  
17 animal may convert that prize to a cash prize. The animal to be raffled may be  
18 donated to or purchased by the organization. The donor or seller of the animal  
19 shall determine the market value of the animal. If the person who wins the animal  
20 desires a cash prize instead of the animal, the organization shall pay the player a  
21 cash prize that must equal the lesser of the market value of the animal or the  
22 maximum single cash prize amount allowed under section 53-06.1-10.1.
- 23 3. A person may not give away any live animal, other than those authorized under  
24 subsections 1 and 2, as:
