- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to curriculum-based achievement college entrance examinations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Curriculum-based achievement college entrance examinations Administration 7 Reporting of scores.
- 8 In April of each school year, the superintendent of public instruction shall 1. 9 administer to public school students in grade eleven a curriculum-based 10 achievement college entrance examination in the areas of reading, English, and mathematics. 11 12 2. Before June thirtieth of each year, each school shall report to the superintendent of 13 public instruction its mean score on the examination, the number of eleventh grade 14 students who took the examination, and the percentage of eleventh grade students 15 who took the examination. If fewer than five students take the examination, only 16 the school's total score may be made public. 17 3. This section does not apply to any student who has an individualized education 18 program plan documenting that the student's disability is a substantial cause for 19 the student's inability to read and comprehend the test.
- Before June thirtieth of each year, each school shall report a student's test results
 to the student's parents.
