4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 54-21.3-03 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

The governing body of a city, township, or county that elects to administer and
enforce a building code shall adopt and enforce the state building code. However,
the state building code may be amended by cities, townships, and counties to
conform to local needs <u>if the local standards meet or exceed those of the state</u>
building code.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-21.3-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:

14 54-21.3-05. Enforcement of code by city, township, or county - Relinquishment. 15 A Each city or township may shall administer and enforce the state building code only within its 16 jurisdictional area. A county may shall administer and enforce the state building code within 17 those areas of the county in which the state building code is not administered by a city or 18 township. Cities and townships may relinguish their authority to administer and enforce the 19 state building code to the county in which they are located in the manner provided by section 20 11-33-20. The governing body of a each city, township, or and county electing to administer 21 and enforce the state building code may shall designate an a building code enforcement 22 agency. Cities, townships, and counties may, provide by agreement for joint administration and 23 enforcement and may, or contract for private enforcement of the state building code.
