

**HOUSE BILL NO. 1301**

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact subsection 10 to section 54-44.1-06 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to requiring bonding information in the budget data contents; and to  
3 amend and reenact section 54-44.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to budget  
4 reports to the legislative assembly.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 **SECTION 1.** Subsection 10 of section 54-44.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
7 created and enacted as follows:

8 10. A detailed report on all authorizations for issuing evidences of indebtedness by  
9 state agencies and institutions included in the executive budget, including the  
10 proposed purposes, amounts to finance, anticipated proceeds, anticipated  
11 repayment terms, and sources of funds for repayments.

12 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-44.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
13 amended and reenacted as follows:

14 **54-44.1-08. Budget report - Contents - When submitted to legislative assembly.**

15 The official budget report must be transmitted by the governor to all holdover legislators and  
16 legislators-elect not later than three days after the commencement of the session of the  
17 legislative assembly. Such report is not a third-class item under section 46-02-05. The budget  
18 director shall provide for the duplication or other satisfactory reproduction or printing of the  
19 official budget report, so as to ensure delivery of same as provided in this section. Such reports  
20 must contain the budget and revenue proposals recommended by the governor and the  
21 information required in subsections 1, 2, 3, 5, ~~and 6,~~ and 10 of section 54-44.1-06 and all other  
22 data and information as the governor shall decide. The budget director shall make available  
23 any and all information regarding budget data to the governor, the legislative assembly and its  
24 designees, legislators, and to the governor-elect as may be requested. The governor may
