- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-39.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to computation of service credit under the teachers' fund for retirement.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-39.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **15-39.1-27. Computation of years of service <u>- Service credits</u>.** In computing the

terms of service of a member under this chapter, for a member employed full time, a year is

- 8 deemed to be one hundred seventy-five days of compensation. Employment less than one
- 9 hundred seventy-five days of compensation is not deemed to be a full year but only as the
- 10 proportion of a year as the number of hours employed in each year of service bears to seven
- 11 hundred hours. A nonretired member of the fund who is a member of the fund on August 1,
- 12 2005, who received less than one year of service credit for teaching kindergarten programs in a
- 13 public school before July 1, 1987, is entitled to retroactive service credit as provided in this
- 14 <u>section</u>. The service credit is based on the number of hours the member worked in each fiscal
- 15 year in proportion to seven hundred hours. Under procedures adopted by the board, a
- 16 <u>nonretired member is entitled to apply for retroactive credit as provided in this section. The</u>
- 17 member must provide employer records or other documentation approved by the board which
- 18 verifies the actual hours employed in a fiscal year. Upon review of the application and
- 19 <u>verification of the hours worked, the board shall grant applicable service credit to the member.</u>
- 20 A member may not receive more than one year of service credit for any fiscal year.
